Registration for the 2024-2025 school year

Registration for the 2023-2024 school year is now open online for returning students. Guardians will need a valid email address and a Skyward Family Access login (student logins do not work for online registration). Please click <u>HERE</u> to register. All student fees can be paid online, but they do not have to be paid at this time to complete registration. In an effort to provide your child with the greatest opportunity for success, please find a reminder of our Truancy Guidelines below and the importance of school attendance. Our day starts at 8 am and we dismiss at 2:25 pm.

1. Regular attendance is crucial to every student's success.

- 2. It is important that your child is at school on time. This does not mean dropping your child off right at the time school starts or after. Being late means your child is missing important instructional time.
- 3. Please be proactive in calling your student's school to report absences. Schools request that you please call before 9 am on the day of the absence.
- 4. Please refer to your Alton School District calendar (pages 3 & 4) for guidelines concerning excused and unexcused absences. A copy of the calendar is also available online at altonschools.org.

If you take your student to the clinic, doctor, or emergency room, please ask for a signed excuse. The excused slip should be sent to school with your child on the day they return. Medical offices can also fax it to (618) 463-2121.
